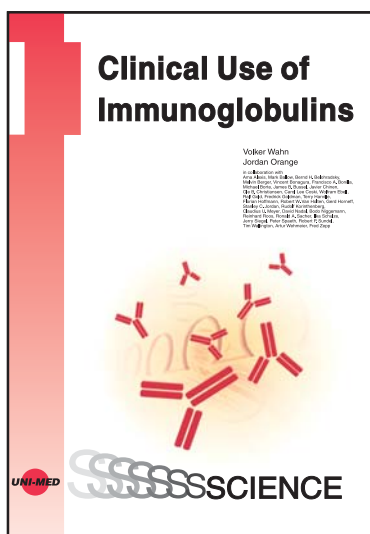


## Clinical Use of Immunoglobulins
